GENEVA, March 1.—Prince Peter Kropotkin has just returned to Locarno from a short trip through Europe. The Swiss newspapers say that he intends to settle with his family in the United States. Prince Kropotkin passes most of the year in his villa at Locarno, and occasionally the question of his expulsion comes before the Swiss authorities. It is naturally being asked whether the United States will harbor him.
