

## **PRINCE KROPOTKIN NOT DEAD**

**Report Was False, but Russian  
Revolutionist Is Seriously Ill.**

LONDON, Feb. 3.—The condition of Prince Peter A. Kropotkin, Russian author and revolutionary leader, who recently was erroneously reported to have died in Moscow, must be considered serious, says a wireless dispatch from Moscow today. Little hope is entertained for his recovery.

A London dispatch of Jan. 20, quoting a Copenhagen message to the Exchange Telegraph Company, reported the death of Prince Kropotkin in Moscow, but a London dispatch printed Feb. 1 in the *Russky Golos* (Russian Voice) of New York City contradicted the Copenhagen dispatch. It said Prince Kropotkin was recovering from his illness.
